




There was a decrease in activity in January 2024 compared to the prior year experienced in traffic stops, reports written, all calls for service, and the number of arrests/charges filed.


The following chart represents January Computer Aided Dispatch events with a mental health aspect from 2019 – 2024.



There were eight OWI incident counts during the month of January 2024. Testing was refused in two of the cases and urine samples were submitted for testing in two additional incidents. In the remaining cases, the Datamaster BAC ranged from .078 to .191, with the average Datamaster BAC being .128. There were twenty OWI incident counts during January 2023. Testing was refused in four incidents and drugs were involved in another. In the remaining cases, the Datamaster, the Datamaster BAC ranged from .033 to .296, with the average Datamaster BAC being .152.

There were four public intoxication reports during January 2024. Testing was refused in one incident and unable to be done in another. The BAC was .147 and .244 in the remaining two incidents. There were two public intoxication reports for the month of January 2023. Testing was refused in one incident, and the BAC was .063 in the other incident.

The contour chart below shows all calls for service by day and time for the month of January 2024. The busiest times recorded were Sundays during the hours of 2100-2300, Mondays between the hours of 1000-1200, 1700-1800, and 2000-2300, Tuesdays between the hours of 1700-1800, Wednesdays between the hour of 1300-1400, and Fridays between the hours of 2000-2100 and 2100-2200.
