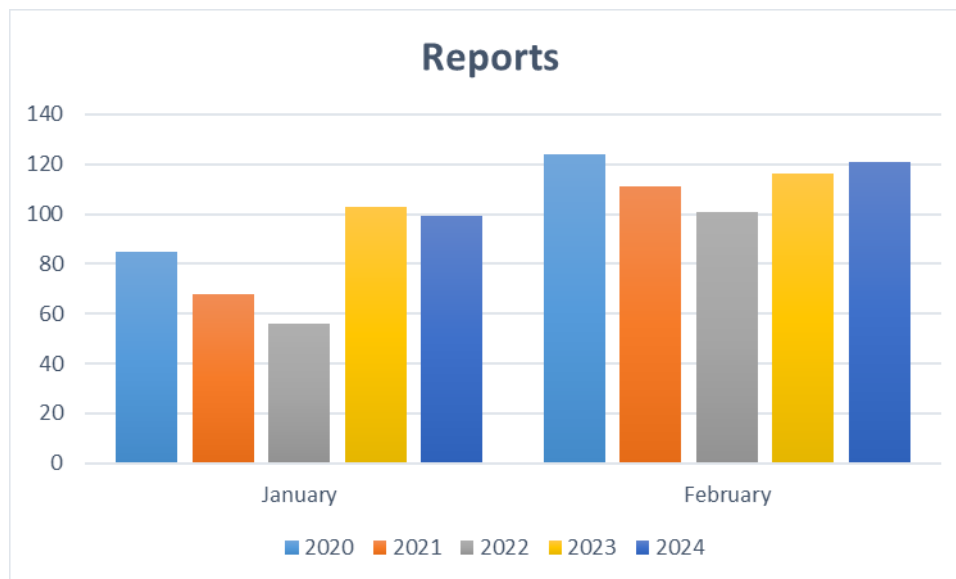

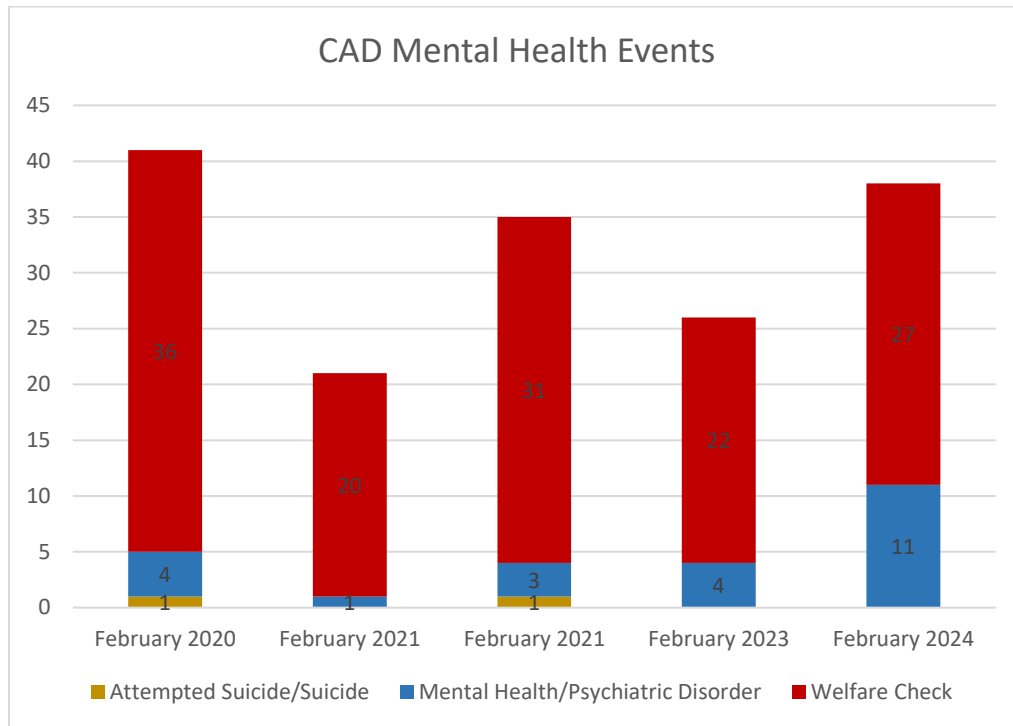

There was a decrease in most activity in February 2024 compared to the prior year even with the extra February day. However, theft and trespassing incidents did increase. For February, traffic stops were down 16.6%, calls for service were down 12.6%, arrests were down 28.9%, and the number of charges were down 37.1%. Reports written were up 4.3% and outreach events were up 96.0

There was 1 report of a stolen bicycle during February of 2024, a locked Schwinn valued at \$150 was taken from 71 Frederiksen Court between 12/18/23 – 2/1/24. There was 1 report of a stolen bicycle during January of 2024.

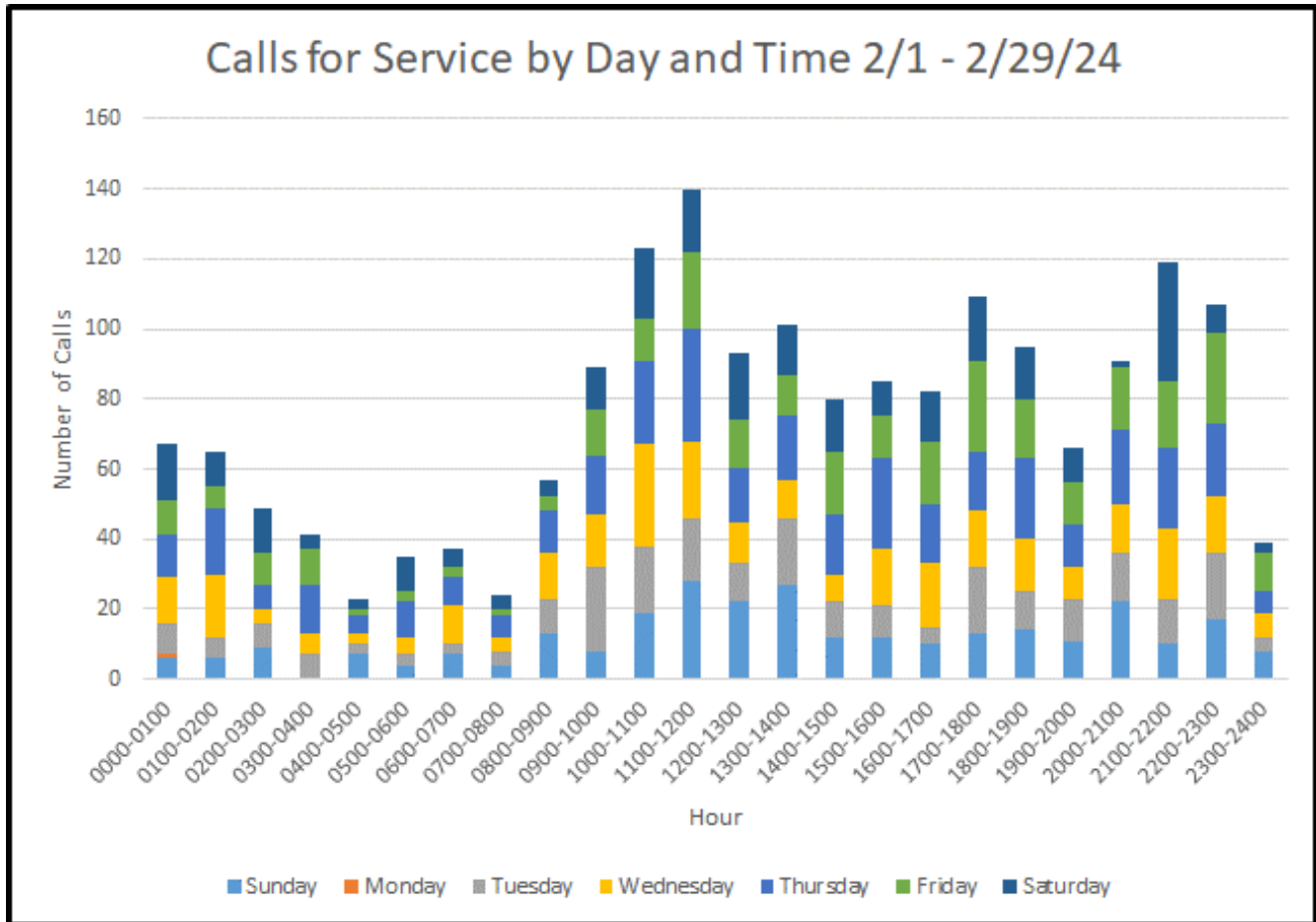
The following chart represents January Computer Aided Dispatch events with a mental health aspect from 2019 – 2024.



There were five OWI incident counts during the month of February 2024. Testing was refused in one of the cases. In the remaining cases, the Datamaster BAC ranged from .122 to .207, with the average Datamaster BAC being .168. During February of 2023 there were thirteen OWI incident counts. Testing was refused in three incidents and drugs were involved in two other incidents. In the remaining cases, the Datamaster BAC ranged from .085 to .233, with the average Datamaster BAC being .149.

There were five public intoxication reports during February 2024. Testing was refused in two incidents and unable to be done in another. The BAC ranged from .144 to .207 in the remaining incidents, with the average BAC being .180. There were three public intoxication reports for the month of February 2023. The BAC ranged from .190 to .227, and the average BAC was .214.

The contour chart below shows all calls for service by day and time for the month of February 2024. The busiest times recorded were Sundays during the hours of 0900-1100, Mondays between the hours of 1100-1400 and 2000-2100, Tuesdays between the hour of 0900-1000, Wednesdays between the hours of 1000-1200, Thursdays between the hours of 1000-1200, 1500-1600, 1800-1900 and 2000-2300, Fridays between the hours of 1100-1200, 1700-1800, and 2200-2300, and Saturdays between the hour of 2100-2200.
