## Introduction

The Iowa State University Police Department provides professional law enforcement services while working cooperatively with the community in a proactive partnership. The ISU PD is authorized 42 fully certified sworn police officers and 11 certified dispatchers providing 24/7 emergency response.

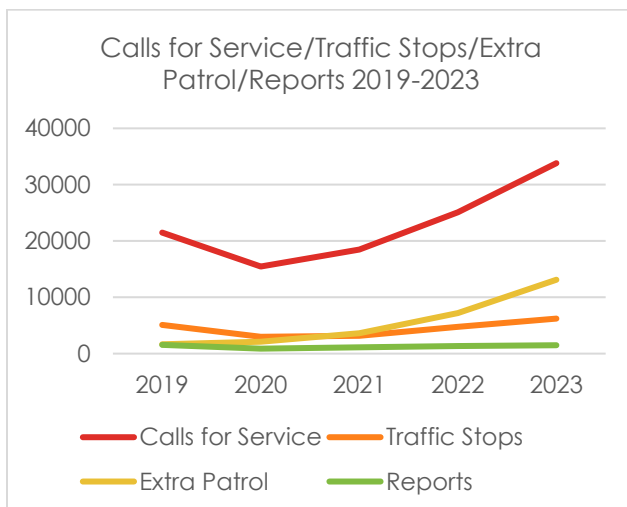
While the main jurisdiction is the ISU campus and outlying properties owned or controlled by the University, a 28E agreement partnering with law enforcement agencies in Story County allows ISU PD officers to patrol and investigate alleged criminal offenses outside of the ISU campus. The ISU campus contains approximately 2.8 square miles and enrollment for the 2023 fall semester was 30,177 students. The community of Ames covers approximately 24 square miles with a population of nearly 67,000.

This report provides a five-year comparison of a variety of activities conducted by the Iowa State Police Department. Examining data over time can be useful in determining trends and patterns and can provide insight for the efficient allocation of resources. In the data presented in this report, CAD refers to Computer Aided Dispatch.

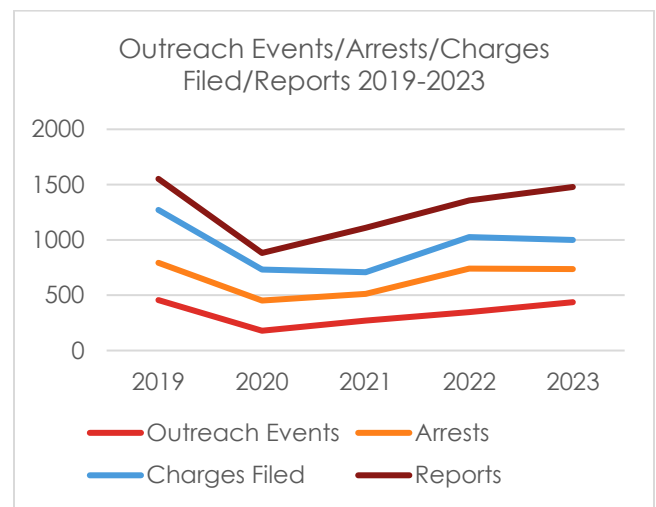

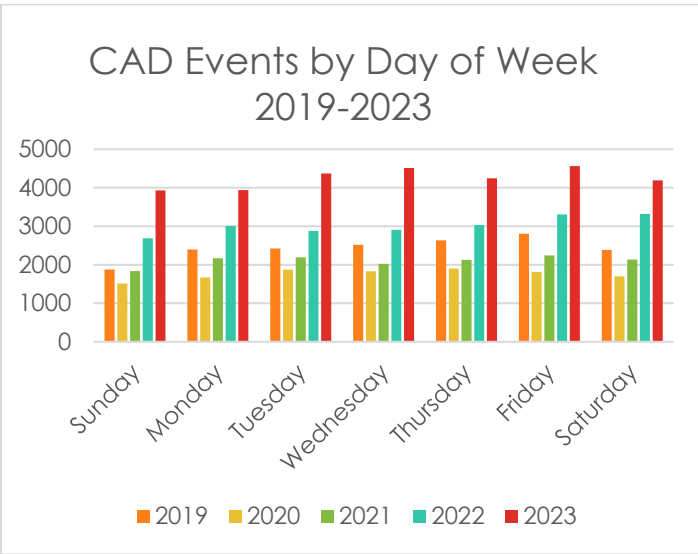

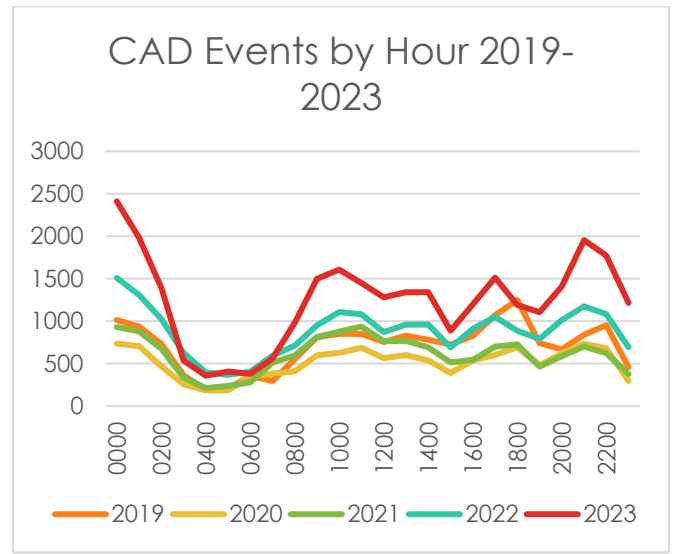

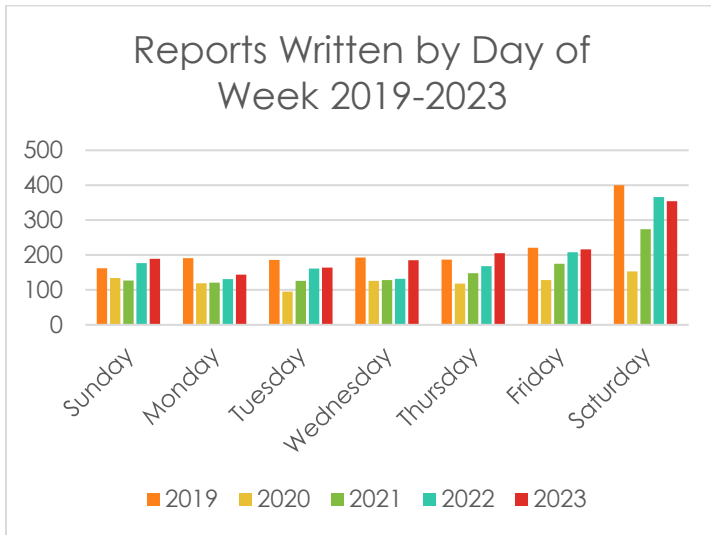
**CAD Events by Day of the Week Calendar  
Years 2019-2023**



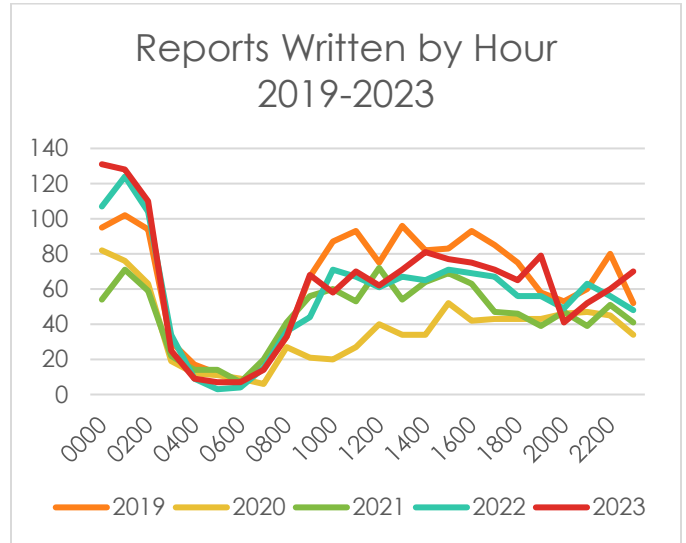
**CAD Events by Hour Calendar

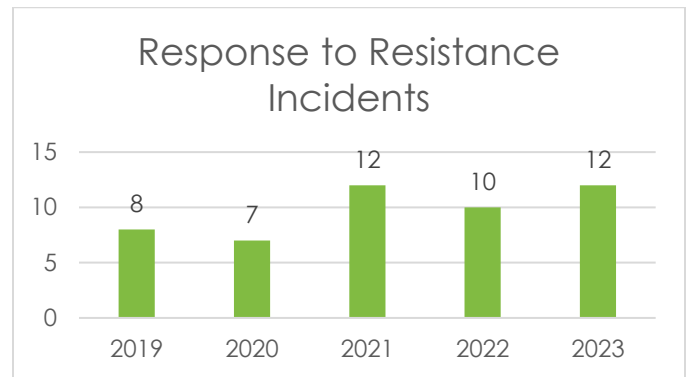

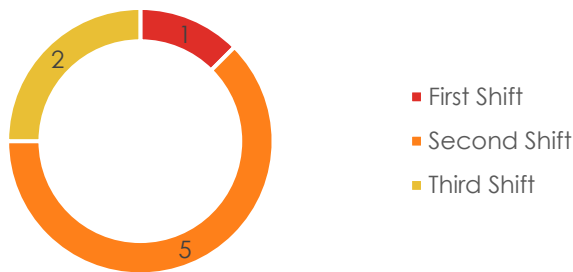
2019 Response to Resistance Incidents by Race



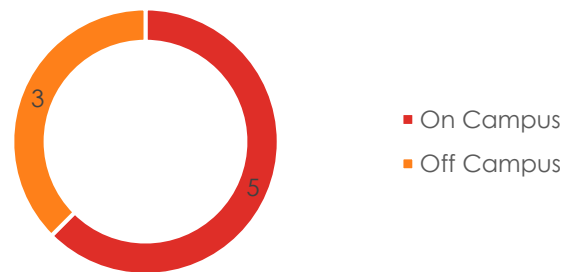
2019 Response to Resistance Incidents Circumstances



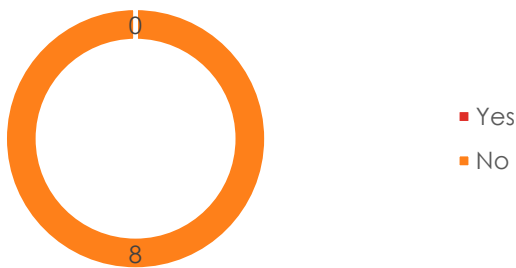
2019 Response to Resistance Incidents by Shift



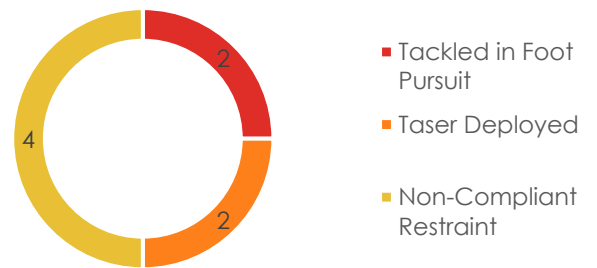
2019 Response to Resistance Incidents by Location

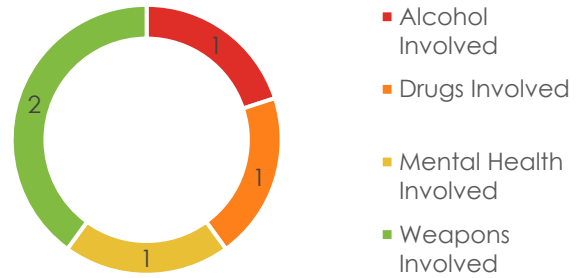

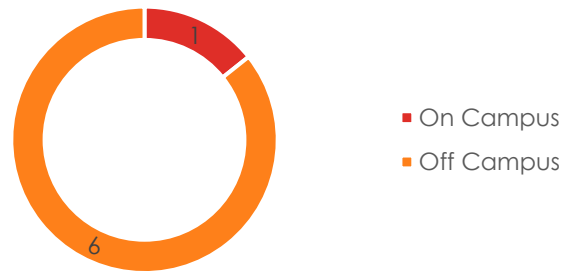
2020 Response to Resistance Incidents Circumstances



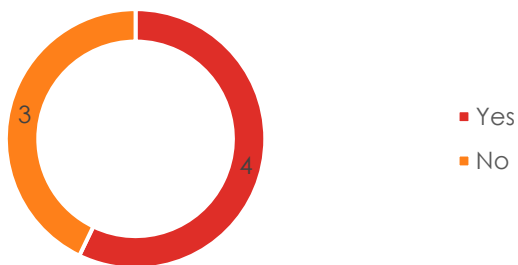
2020 Response to Resistance Incidents by Shift



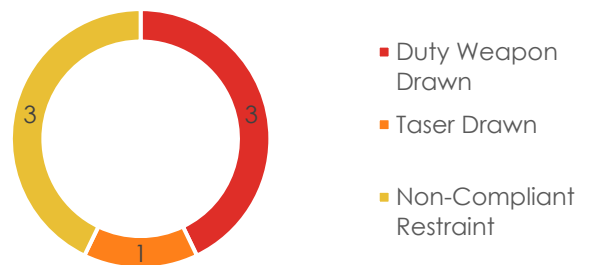
2020 Response to Resistance Incidents by Location

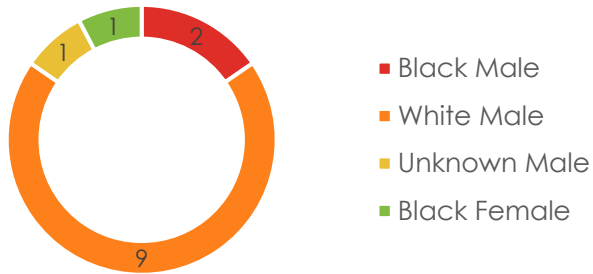


2020 Response to Resistance Incidents by Use of Force

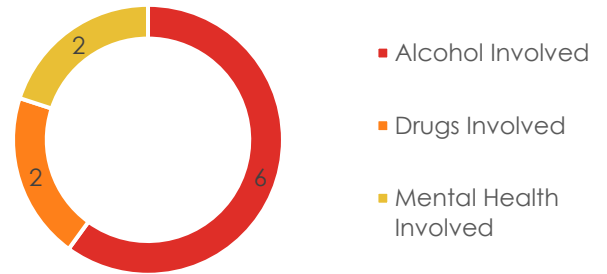

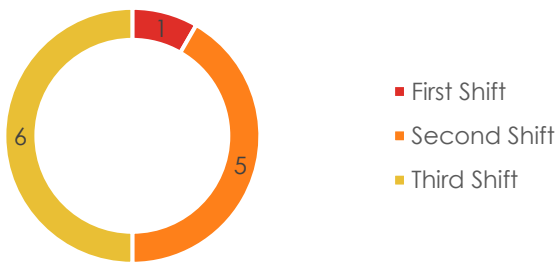
2021 Response to Resistance Incidents by Race



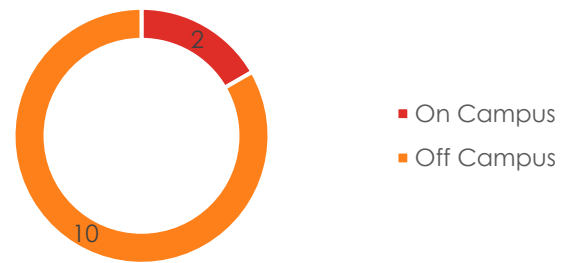
2021 Response to Resistance Incidents Circumstances



2021 Response to Resistance Incidents by Shift



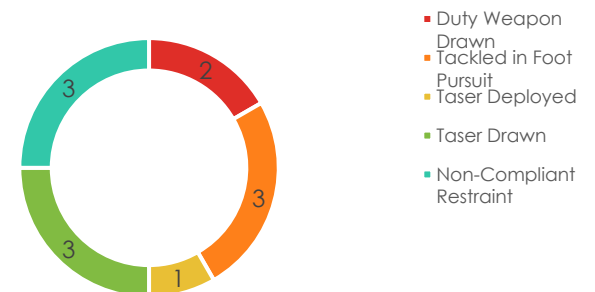
2021 Response to Resistance Incidents by Location

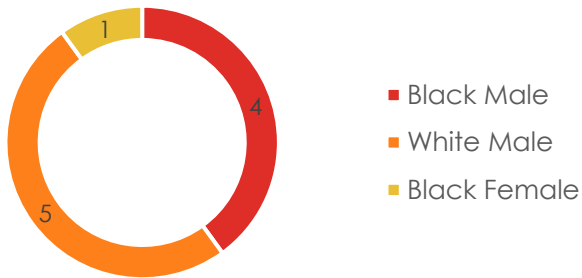


2021 Response to Resistance Incidents by Use of Force

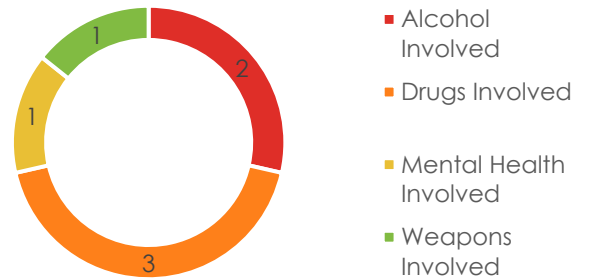




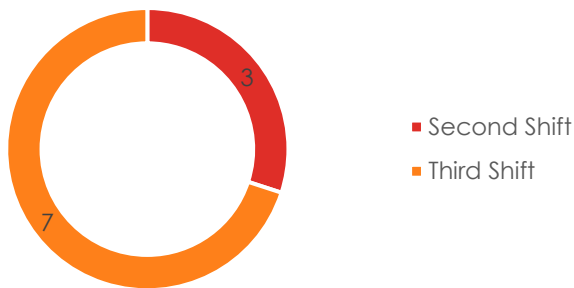
2022 Response to Resistance Incidents by Race



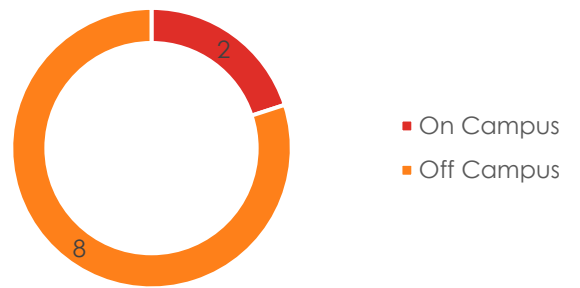
2022 Response to Resistance Incidents Circumstances



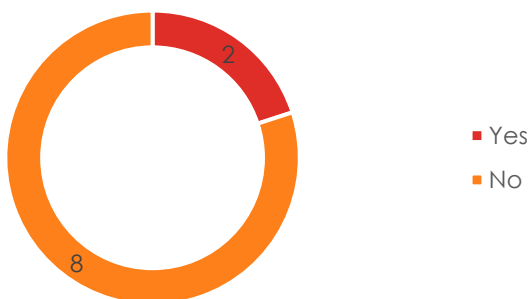
2022 Response to Resistance Incidents by Shift



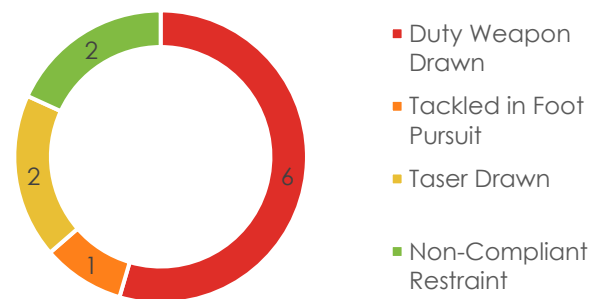
2022 Response to Resistance Incidents by Location

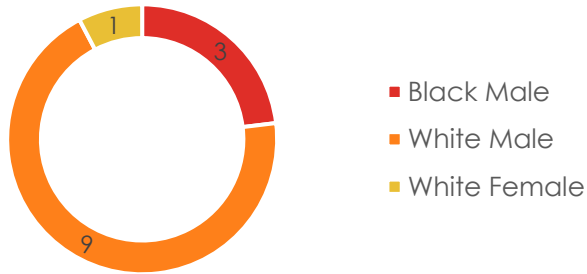


2022 Response to Resistance Incidents Use of Force

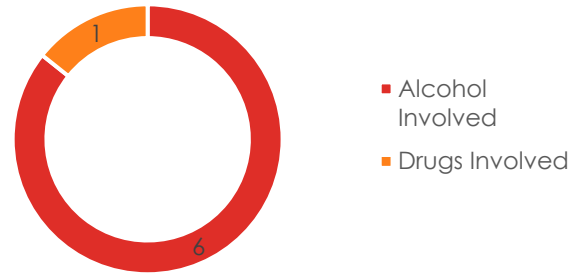

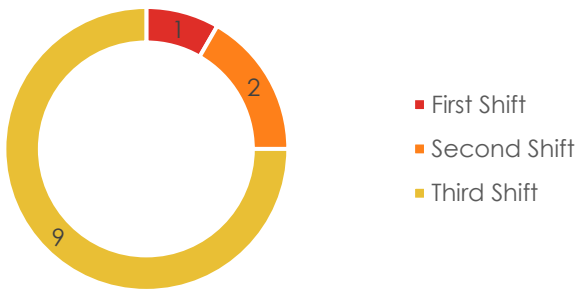
2023 Response to Resistance Incidents by Race



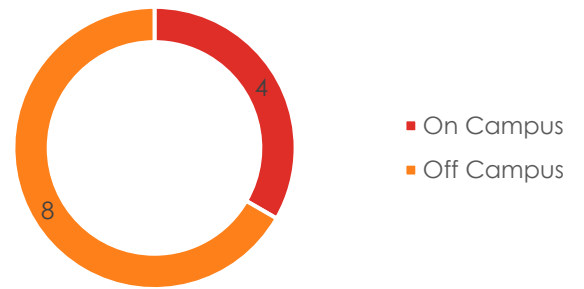
2023 Response to Resistance Incidents Circumstances



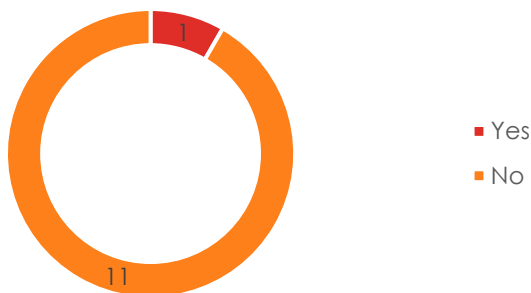
2023 Response to Resistance Incidents by Shift



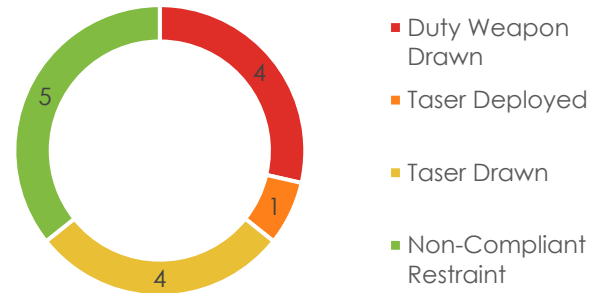
2023 Response to Resistance Incidents by Location

### Closing Comments

- Activity for the 2019-2020 and 2020-2021 academic school years was definitely impacted by the Covid-19 pandemic because of fewer students being on campus.
- The most CAD events in the years 2019, 2021, and 2023 occurred on Fridays. In 2022 the most CAD events were entered on Saturdays.
- The highest number of reports are written by the ISU PD on Saturdays, probably in relation to football game tailgating and other Saturday special events.
- The highest number of CAD events, consistently for the last four years, were extra patrols, traffic stops, and alarms.
- The highest number of charges, consistently for 2021-2023, were alcohol violations, traffic/driving violations, narcotic violations and OWIs.
- Harassment was in the ten most charges for 2023. This is the first time since the compilation of this report began that harassment has been at this level and reflects the increase in individuals filing harassment reports.
- Most incidents requiring a response to resistance occurred during the third shift and off campus.
- In 58.3% of response to resistance incidents in 2023, drug and/or alcohol usage was a factor.
- Tasers were drawn in four separate response to resistance incidents in 2023 but deployed only once.
